

Minutes of the regular monthly meeting of the Town of Leola Board of Supervisors held on April 12, 2011

Meeting was **called to order** by Chairman Ken Zimbeck at 6:28 p.m. Board Members Ken Zimbeck and Orin Nigh, clerk, and treasurer were present. Ted Jansen joined the meeting at 6:35 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Motion by Orin/Ken to **approve minutes** of the March 16, 2011 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report showed a balance in all accounts of \$159,725.57. Motion by Orin/Ken to accept this report. Motion carried.

New business:

1. Review, with possible action Packets from Leroy Stoelaski and Vierbicher Associates if both have been received, for the need of an independent building inspector. – Information packet was not received as the time of the meeting. Will review next month even if the packet is not received.

Supervisor Ted Jansen arrived at this point.

2. Review, with possible action — All Terrain Vehicle Ordinance #2-2011 –Discussion with Chris VanKuiken as to what was taken into account when deciding on the ATV ordinance. ATV were originally meant to be an off road vehicle and not transportation between Alcoholic establishments. The concern of the noise level that is created along with the ATV being uninsured motorist. The ordinance from the Town of Pine Grove was review and the concern of the ATV's using only half of the road in Portage County to the town line due to the Town of Grant not approving an ordinance in their township. It was felt that this could cause some confusion and safety issues. The Board wants to have the original requester (Kevin Sawyer) come to a meeting to explain the thinking behind the Pine Grove/Grant difference of opinion and how it would impact the use of that portion of the route. Motion by Ted/Orin to reject the ordinance till when more definitive action is taken.
3. Discuss, with possible action the need for new shelter for the site attendant. Ted to report on options and cost for shelter. – Ted is getting quotes from place in Plover across from JayMar and one in Wautoma. Will present quotes at next meeting.
4. Review, with possible action the yearly town calendar. – The 12 page calendar will be used for this year; Clerk will work on creating a one page yearly calendar that can be mailed to citizens with tax bills.
5. Set date for Annual Road Inspection. – Date set for May 2nd at 5:00 p.m. with the review of report at the May 18 meeting.
